



**The 2005 UNIFIED PROGRAM AGENCY
ENVIRONMENTAL LEADERSHIP AWARDS**

PROGRAM STATEMENT: In a concise, one or two-page format (not to exceed 500 words), please describe the organization, program, or individual being nominated and indicate why the nominee should be awarded a UNIFIED PROGRAM AGENCY ENVIRONMENTAL LEADERSHIP AWARD. Among the items that should be addressed in this statement are:

- What major impact and/or specific role did the nominee make in the field of environmental protection through educational activities, the development of a special program, involvement in the legislative process, or any special achievement during the calendar year of 2005 that enhances the protection of the environment and/or public health and safety.

SUMMARY STATEMENT: Summarize the purpose, objectives, and/or accomplishments of the program, organization, or individual being nominated. The statement should not exceed 100 words and should be suitable for use in a catalog, database, or brochure.

SUPPORTING MATERIALS: You may attach up to ten pages of supporting materials to this application. Such material may include graphic presentations, brochures, photographs, reports, newspaper articles, etc. Supporting materials may not be used as a substitute for the above written statement.

EXTERNAL ENDORSEMENTS: Include with your application two letters of recommendation for the program, individual, or organization being nominated. References must be knowledgeable and familiar with the nominee's accomplishments for which they are being nominated.

ELIGIBILITY: The competition is open to all Certified Program Agencies, Participating Agencies, State Unified Program Agencies, federal agencies, non-government organizations, industry/trade associations, academia and legislators. The awards will be presented for achievements either undertaken or completed in 2005. (**Please note:** Individual awards are not open to industry/trade associations and non-government organizations.)

SELECTION: A Selection Committee will evaluate all applications for accomplishments in five specific areas: (1) Specific contributions that enhanced environmental protection and/or public health and safety; (2) Outstanding leadership; (3) Enhancement of communication between Unified Program Agencies, industry, non-government organizations, and/or the community; (4) Innovation/uniqueness; and (5) Program results. The deliberation process of the Selection Committee is confidential. A nomination may be considered in a category different from that in which it is nominated. Winners will be awarded an engraved plaque or similar type award at the 8th Annual California Unified Program Conference in February 2006.
